## **Balmoral Cemetery Visitors Guide**

**Visiting times:** Balmoral Cemetery may be visited during daylight hours, on any

day of the year.

**Access:** Vehicle and pedestrian access to the cemetery grounds is via gates

located in Wynnum Road or gates in Bennetts Road, Morningside.

**Parking:** There is no designated car park on site, but cars may be parked in

some open space areas without hindering other vehicles.

**Dogs:** Dogs are welcome in the cemetery provided they are restrained on a

leash. Dog owners are reminded to pick up after their dogs (Council

fines are now in place).

Water: Taps are located in various areas around the grounds. Please ensure

that taps are properly turned off after use.

**Amenities:** Two shelter sheds with seating are available for visitors, located at the

apex of the hill and at road level near the Bennetts Road gates.

**Section signage:** Balmoral Cemetery has no section signage, but a location map is on

display at both the Wynnum and Bennetts Road entrances.

**Toilets:** There are no public toilets on site.

**Bins:** Wheelie-style bins with lids are available for use by visitors. The Friends

of Balmoral Cemetery use industrial skips for green waste disposal.

**Sexton:** Balmoral Cemetery does not have an on-site Sexton. For information

about cemetery management, please contact the Hemmant Cemetery
